

2006/07 SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS

he Nebraska Cooperative Council Education Foundation awarded eight scholarships totaling \$6,200 for the 2006/07 academic year to students at the University of Nebraska- Lincoln (UNL) College of Agricultural Sciences & Natural Resources and the Nebraska College of Technical Agiculture (NCTA) at Curtis.

The scholarship program was initiated for the 1993/94 academic year with funding from voluntary contributions from cooperatives which are members of the Council. Since the program's inception, 107 scholarships totaling \$79,350 have been awarded.

To be eligible for the scholarships, students must express an interest in or be majoring in agricultural business/economics at UNL; or business/management or ag production systems with the business option at NCTA; or agribusiness at Chadron State College. Eligibility is restricted to sons/daughters of a parent/ legal guardian who has been an active member, director, or employee for at least the prior three years of a cooperative which has been a member in good standing of the Council for at least five years. Other criteria are used by UNL, NCTA, and Chadron State in selecting recipients.

The seven recipients of \$800 scholarships at UNL include one incoming student and six upperclass students. They are:

Jared Niewohner, son of John Ə Joan Niewohner of Lyons. Jared is an incoming student majoring in Ag Sales and Agribusiness. The Niewohner's are members of Central Valley Ag Co-op in O'Neill.





Michael Bartels, son of David ∂ Nancy Bartels of Riverton. Michael is a junior majoring in Ag Economics. The Bartels' are members of Midland Co-op in Funk.
