2006/07 SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS

he Nebraska Cooperative Council Education
Foundation awarded eight scholarships totaling
\$6,200 for the 2007/08 academic year to students at
the University of Nebraska - Lincoln (UNL) College of
Agricultural Sciences & Natural Resources and the
Nebraska College of Technical Agriculture (NCTA) at
Curtis.

The scholarship program was initiated for the 1993/94 academic year with voluntary contribution funding from cooperatives which are members of the Council. Since the program's inception, 115 scholarships totaling \$85,550 have been awarded.

To be eligible for the scholarships, students must express an interest in or be majoring in agricultural business/economics at UNL; business/management or ag production systems with the business option at NCTA; or a major or minor in agribusiness at Chadron State College. Eligibility is restricted to sons or daughters of a parent or legal guardian who has been an active member, director, or employee for at least the prior three years of a cooperative which has been a member in good standing of the Council for at least five years. Other criteria are used by UNL, NCTA, and Chadron State College in selecting recipients.
